TRANSFERABLE PREREQUISITE COURSES

The CCAC courses, which have been identified as transferable in meeting the CDN Prerequisite Course Requirements are listed on page 2.

Note:

The Introductory Nutrition course listed on page 2 as CDN/HRS 1006 is a human nutrition course offered by the CDN Department to meet specific accreditation standards of education. A review of the course objectives and syllabus for the CCAC course, DIT 106 Nutrition Care 1, indicates that this course is equivalent to CDN/HRS 1006 and therefore is the course that is accepted as the transferable introductory nutrition course. The Bio 117 Nutrition course is not accepted as equivalent.
